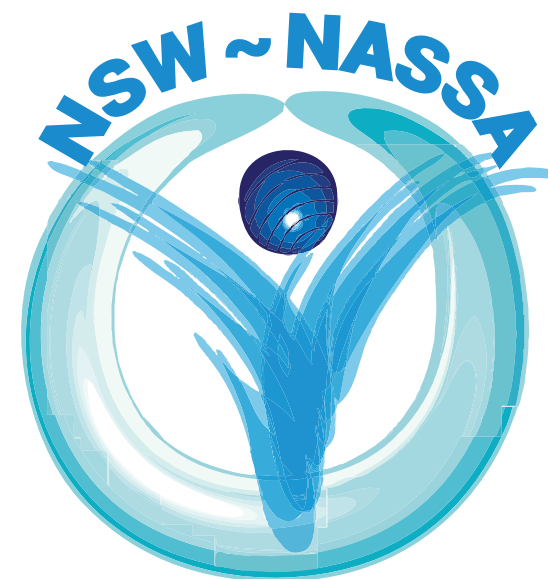

NASSA HAS AN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE WHO HAVE BEEN ELECTED BY THE MEMBERS ON A YEARLY BASIS.

The Committee consists of a Chairperson, Treasurer, Secretary, Regional Representative Liaison Officer and General Members.

Each region in NSW has a Regional Representative who is available to assist members at a local level.

The Executive Committee members and the Regional Representatives do so on a voluntary basis as they also run their own services.
